Goat Farming

Kalu Bhat is 40 years old and lives in Ridikot VDC in the Achham District. She lives with her husband, three sons, one daughter-in-law, and one granddaughter. Her husband used to work in India as a guard but they were still having trouble making enough money to support their family.

She participated through the Navadeep Community Organization in partnership with DWO and the Poverty Alleviation Fund to establish a goat farming enterprise. She received 24,000 Rupees and invested 3,000 Rupees of her own to start the business. Kalu says she is making good money now which goes to cover house expenses, health treatments for her family, education, and maintaining the business. With this new access to income, she is planning to expand from goat farming into other animal husbandry.
