### Goat Farming

Khali Sunar lives in the Ridikot VDC in the Achham District. Her family consists of 15 people but she currently lives only with her husband. Two of her sons are educated but needed to leave Nepal to find work. Much of the rest of her family is living in India to try and make ends meet. Through DWO's facilitation and financial support of the Poverty Alleviation Fund, Khali received 18,400 Rupees

to purchase 3 goats. Through breeding and some sale of the goats she now has 7 animals and is happy with her earnings from goat farming so far.

She had this to say about the program: “nowadays, I and my husband are very busy and feel comfortable. We can pay the house expenses and for health treatments.”
